Student Success Infrastructure (Dan Kernler)

Opportunities to participate as follows:

Equity Coordinating Council members (2-3)

We are looking to get additional faculty voices on the Equity Coordinating Council (the main decision-making body associated with the Student Success Infrastructure), without necessarily aligning them with a specific task. These positions would sit on the council and help shape the decisions of the council, with very little outside work expected. They would be considered committee members only. We have bi-weekly meetings on Thursdays from 3:30-5pm. Our next meeting (and last for Fall 2017) is on Thursday, 12/7, in E106.

Team Co-Leader

We also have one new team that will begin its work during the Spring 2018 semester, which is the **Supporting Undocumented/DACA Students Team.** This group is looking for ways to support our undocumented/DACA students, including providing guidance for faculty and staff on this issue. The administrative co-leader is Rodrigo Lopez, the Director of High School Partnerships and Transitions.

The faculty member filling this position would be expected to attend Equity Coordinating Council meetings and also hold meetings with their team on alternating weeks. They are expected to champion the mission of SSI, which can include crafting new initiatives, advocating for policies/procedures relating to their team, or guiding new initiative proposals through the SSI approval process. *This position is compensated as outlined in the Extra-Contractual document and will start in the Spring Semester.*

NOTE: The 2 or 3 Equity Coordinating Council members could start immediately, while the co-leader would start in Spring (but is welcome at our last meeting this semester on Thursday, December 7th.
